Rationale:

As a school we have a duty of care to our students and staff when weather becomes extreme. This policy addresses our actions when the weather is extremely hot.

Policy Points:

- 1.1 This policy becomes relevant when the lunch time temperature in Stirling reaches 38 degrees.
- 1.2 Unless determined by leadership because of the nature of the weather, all students will go out to morning recess and be encouraged to sit or play in the shade.
- 1.3 Leadership will ring the same bells as for wet weather at the start of lunch period if the Hot Weather Policy is to come into play.
- 1.4 Hot Weather will operate the same as for Wet Weather. All students stay in classes with teacher supervision. Teacher may share the supervision to allow for toilet and drink breaks.
